Lazy Texan spice mixes now available online, in Wimberley

It's cheese ball season, and a Wimberley business owner has launched a new line of seasoning and dip mixes to help make yours extra delicious.

Jane Wyatt's Lazy Texan spice mixes come in a variety of flavors, including onion, hot onion, jalapeño and an all-purpose mix that has just enough heat to keep things interesting.

Wyatt is the kind of cook who prefers recipes with five ingredients or fewer, and she's created a cookbook of recipes for dishes (beyond dips and cheese balls) that use her spices, including grilled chicken and cornbread.

She's also working on a salsa mix to launch in 2016 that would only require the home cook to open a can of diced tomatoes.
